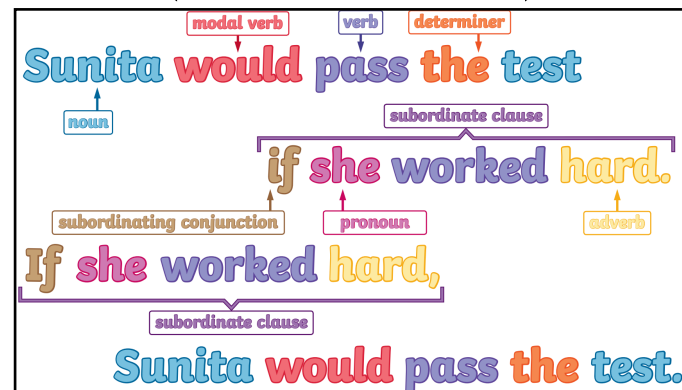

Review- Subordinate clauses

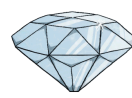

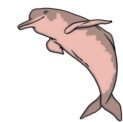
Amazon Rainforest Animals Word Mat
